## We are delighted to share comprehensive and transparent details of our fee structure.

There are several factors to be aware of when comparisons are made between different schools, both locally and nationally.

- Our fees include free, supervised wrap around care for all Prep and Senior School pupils from 7.45am to 5.00pm daily.
- Our fees also reflect our smaller class sizes throughout the school. In the 2023-24 summer term, our average year group size in Prep was 11 pupils, and our average class size in the Senior School was just 13.
- Our Nursery fees are the most competitively priced locally for the excellent standard of care and the exceptional school-wide facilities that are utilised.
- We are proud to offer a through education from 3-18 years. By running a Sixth Form, we attract a different calibre of subject teachers whose experience and knowledge trickles down to our very youngest pupils.
- Indeed, our Prep children are taught Computing, PE, Music and Modern Foreign Languages by specialist staff who lead these curriculum areas to A-level.
- Our fees are inclusive of textbooks and writing materials.

School lunch is mandatory for all children and is charged at £275 per term.

*\*Nursery and Reception (under 5 years) fees are shown net of the Early Years Funding Grant (15 hours). The school is a registered provider of Early Years Provision and funding is available from the start of the term your child turns three. We accept all employer nursery voucher schemes.*

*\*\*Direct Debit in ten monthly instalments from 1 August to 1 May inclusive. This method of payment is fully backed by the Direct Debit Guarantee Scheme.*

## Other charges

Chromebook maintenance fees (Year 7-11), locker rental (Year 10-13) and public examination fees (if required) are charged at an additional cost.

The school also provides private transport for pupils from across Teesside and North Yorkshire. Details of the routes, timetables and prices can be found on the school website.
