Arrival Procedure

Children should arrive between 8.00am and 8.30am. Upon arrival please report to the school Reception where a member of staff will welcome the children.

Collection Procedure

Each morning you will be asked to select a collection time. On school based days these are either 4.00pm, 4.30pm or 5.00pm. On trip days the options are 4.30pm or 5.00pm. At your chosen time, your child will be dismissed from the school Reception. If an adult unknown to the staff, the adult collecting will be required to supply your password to ensure a safe collection.

Lunch and Snacks

Children are required to bring a packed lunch, snacks and a water bottle each day in a small backpack. Please ensure these are all nut free. Please note fizzy drinks and energy drinks are not allowed. Grapes should be cut length ways for health and safety reasons and glass containers should be avoided.

Clothing

Children should come suitably dressed in home clothes. They will need a waterproof coat each day. Younger children should also have spare clothes in their bag in case of any accidents. For trip days children should bring everything, including lunch, in a single backpack which they can carry and come suitably dressed to enjoy outdoor activities.


Electronic Devices and Personal Possessions
