Transport Provision

Thank you for taking the time to look at the Teesside High School Transport Provision available for the 2026/27 academic year. This year we will have four buses running to ensure availability in line with parental requests and current booking preferences whilst also allowing to keep costing viable for those with a contracted bus pass.

We have worked to streamline the service introducing online bus route enquiries and have a paperless operating system including bus passes available via EduLink for pupils to access via a mobile device.

Please note all pupils will be expected to present their bus pass to the driver ahead of each journey and without this travel upon school transport service will not be permitted.

An interactive bus route guide has been created for prospective school transport users to have a visual representation of the bus routes and coverage available and see exact pin pointed locations of bus stops and compare these in relation to your home address.

If you need any further assistance or would like to discuss transport arrangements from areas not currently served by our network, please contact our Office Manager.

Should there be any issues with the bus schedule please contact M&D directly and hold on the line to select the option for 'having a bus booked'. This will take you through to the out of office hours team to be able to discuss delays and on the day pick up queries.

Types of Passes

Contracted passes such as full and half passes permit the user to use the route that the bus stop states and the bus pass is non transferable to other routes on alternative days or to cover adhoc arrangements.

Full Pass

Permits travel on 5 mornings and 5 evenings per week. This pass has been competitively priced, acknowledging that some pupils may make alternative arrangements once or twice a week when attending after-school fixtures after 4.00pm.

Half Pass

Permits only travel on either 5 mornings or 5 evenings per week. This is priced at 60% of the price of a Full Pass.

Single Journey Passes

Permits travel either one way (SINGLE) or both ways (RETURN).

Single Journey Passes must be purchased at least 24 hours before travel. Without confirmation and receiving a temporary bus pass for the single journey via Edulink travel on the school transport service will not be permitted. Please contact the admin department via email, info@teessidehigh.co.uk, to make arrangements and check availability.

These are charged at £10.00 for a single journey and £15.00 for a return journey.

Single Journey Passes are issued subject to daily availability on each route, and priority is given to existing Full/Half Pass holders if the coach is full.

Single Journey Passes can only be issued to Prep Pupils (Year 3 upwards) if they are travelling with a Senior School Sibling or parent will be meeting at bus stop.

Sibling discount does not apply on Single Journey Passes.

Discounts Available

Sibling Discount

Sibling Discount is available on contracted passes only – not Single Journey passes.

We offer a sibling discount on contracted passes of 25% for the second child, and 50% for the third and subsequent children.

Study Leave Discount

Study Leave Discount will be applied to ALL passes during the Summer Term for those in Year 11 and Year 13.

The price of this pass reflects periods of Study leave for exam candidates during which pupils transport arrangements may vary.

The discount totals the Summer Term bill to be reduced by 50%.

Transport Provision

Conditions of Travel

All Teesside High School Transport users must comply with the following conditions at all times of travel for the safety and comfort of all passengers. Any breach of these conditions may result in the termination of a pupil's school transport agreement without a refund.

USE OF TEESSIDE HIGH SCHOOL'S SCHOOL TRANSPORT PROVISION IS TAKEN AS ACCEPTANCE OF THE BELOW CONDITIONS:

- Pupils must be visibly at the stop 5 minutes before the timetabled time and ready to board. Please do not sit in cars waiting for the coach to arrive.
- Pupils must wear seatbelts and remain in their seats at all times while the vehicle is in motion – this is a legal requirement.
- Inappropriate behaviour or any damage will be reported and investigated. CCTV is installed on most coaches and will be used as evidence in an investigation. In addition to school sanctions, it may also result in passes being withdrawn without refund. The cost of repairs may be charged to your fees.
- The driver is not to be distracted whilst the vehicle is in motion.
- Pupils must not board or dismount the vehicle at any other stop than their booked stop.
- Pupils are responsible for all personal belongings. Items of lost property will need to be arranged to be collected from Teesside High School Main Reception or on occasion the office of our school transport providers.
- Bags and/or any other items must not obstruct the aisles at any time.
- Chewing gum is not permitted on any of our school transport routes.
- Eating or drinking is only permitted if pupils remove their litter when leaving the coach and dispose of all litter properly. Please be respectful of others whilst eating or drinking. There should be no snacks that contain nuts for allergen purposes.
- Pupils must not board the vehicle in dirty sports kit, they must change into clean clothing before travel.
- Bus passes are to be shown to the driver on every journey.
- Single Journey passes are subject to daily availability on each route, and priority is given to contracted passes if the vehicle is full. Single Journey travel requests may not be authorised if less than 24 hours' notice is provided.
- In order to prevent delays to departure, pupils should notify Reception prior to 3.00pm if they have a contracted pass but do not intend to use school transport home on that particular day.

Notice of cancellation – one full term's notice in writing, or email, is required to cancel school travel arrangements. Failure to provide adequate notice will result in charges being payable.

If your child boards the bus, without your consent, without a booking, an administration fee, on top of the daily pass rate, per journey will be charged. The driver can refuse travel if the register is showing the bus is full, or if your child has previously travelled without a booking – in this instance you will need to make alternative arrangements for them.

How do I register my child for a bus pass?



Scan the QR code on the left and complete the online form. A member of our team will process your request.

How will we receive our child's bus pass?

Bus passes will be available via Edulink in the 'documents' section. Pupils will need to have the app installed on their phone so they are able to present their bus pass before each journey. Failure to present the bus pass will mean travel on school transport services is not permitted.

Where is my child's designated bus stop?

Please refer to the [route map](#). If unclear please contact admin for further clarification.

What time should my child arrive at the bus stop?

We would advise all pupils to be present at the bus stop 10 minutes before the estimated time of arrival. Pupils must wait at the bus stop and be visible to the driver.

What happens if we miss the bus?

Contact M&D directly and hold on the line to select the option for 'have a bus booked'. This will take you through to the out of office hours team to be able to discuss delays. Alternatively our office opens from 8.00am and we can get in contact on your behalf.

How will parents be informed should the bus be delayed?

All pupils must carry a mobile phone whilst travelling on school transport for safety reasons however should there be significant delays, if informed by the provider, we will contact all affected parents via Edulink. For smaller delays we would encourage children to contact parents directly.

What should I do if my child's belongings are left on the bus?

Contact the Admin Department who will be able to arrange for the missing items to be reunited.

Is there any flexibility with the routes shown on the map?

Should you wish to make suggestions regarding amendments to bus routes, please contact our Admin Department.

Can my child use the bus on certain days only?

We offer the following transport arrangements:

5x AM travel - Half Pass AM

5x PM travel - Half Pass PM

5x AM + PM travel - Full Pass

For combinations of AM and PM travel - Single Journey Pass
